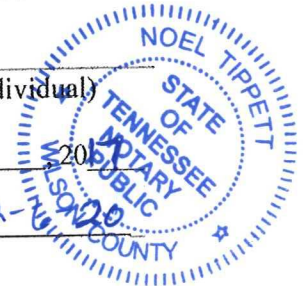

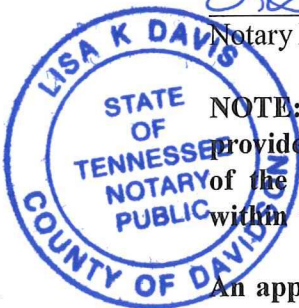

- Depressants (Xanax, Valium):
 - Depressants mixed with alcohol have a synergistic effect
 - Mixing the two can double or triple their effects on the body
- Stimulants (Ritalin, Adderall, Meth):
 - Stimulants mixed with alcohol conceal the effects of the alcohol.
 - In other words people cannot gauge their level of intoxication
 - This can cause people to overconsume alcohol which could lead to death
- Prescriptions Opiates (OxyContin):
 - Opiates mixed with alcohol can result in slowed breathing, lowered blood pressure and could lead to death

When should you call 911? Any life threatening Situation

What is a two party sale?

- When someone attempts to purchase age sensitive products for someone not of age
- Or when someone cannot prove their age
